# Proposed basic FOLK work party programme for April to September 2019

Note that, according to Natural England rules, scrub clearance and grass cutting should be curtailed between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 15<sup>th</sup> July (and tree removal between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 31<sup>st</sup> August). These restrictions do not apply to footpath maintenance or restoration work which can be done with caution.

## Work carried over from previous periods

- Burn cuttings from previous work parties
  - o Small pile just along Woodland Walk from limekilns
  - Ash and dogwood cuttings pile in Area 16
  - Ash cuttings in Salterley Quarry
  - Ash cuttings alongside Hartley Lane near Salterley Quarry entrance
- Consider installing 'street signs' on historic quarrying inclines by the limekilns and possibly the sidings on top of the hill Wayne/Geoff to develop proposals
- Continue trial chemical spraying of stands of Rosebay Willowherb and, if identified, other similar 'weed' stands
- Continue trial chemical spraying of ground-hugging ivy alongside Woodland Walk

#### **Routine work**

- Annual cutting of
  - o Area 16
  - Limekilns
  - Barrow & Butterfly Motorway
  - Sidings
- Raking up grass cuttings in Area 4/5/10 after mowing by contractor (or FOLK) if not baled
- Ragwort (incl. Hopkins Fields) and Hemp Agrimony removal
- Erect temporary paddock in Daisybank Field when requested by Norths
- Footpath and car park clearance/maintenance as required, potentially including:
  - o Repair to steps on steep path beside new builds on Daisy Bank Road
  - o Reprofiling of steps along Woodland Walk
  - Cutting back growth alongside Gallops from new Cotswold stone wall to Minotaur barn
  - o Cutting drainage channels into the Standard Gauge Incline

### **New work**

- Removing by rotational cutting the stand of gorse impacted by malicious fire at the top of Windass and burn all cuttings
- Clearance of area behind Brownstone car park in preparation for its extension
- Rotational cutting of gorse after mid-July, e.g. Area 32 next to Cowslip Meadow
- Further clearance of saplings/trees/growth in Brownstone Quarry and creation of adder hibernacula

#### **Inspection of Previous Works** (to check and report on impact, recovery, need for more work)

- Grassland restoration areas previously cut in Areas 3 & 25
- Where gorse previously cut and chemically treated in Area 28 & 19
- Where gorse rotationally cut in Area 28
- Where ground-hugging ivy and Rosebay Willowherb were chemically treated alongside Woodland Walk (ivy) and Brownstone Quarry & Area 2 (Rosebay Willowherb)

# **Management Plans & QGIS**

- Further development of site management plans and preparation of area specific practical forward work plans utilising the results of the drone photographic survey and QGIS software
  - o Progress gorse management planning and grassland quality identification
- Possible further QGIS mapping work
  - o Recording grassland areas and their species richness
  - o Recording scrub (other than gorse ) locations
  - Recording woodland areas and tree types
  - Recording location of important species
  - o Recording location of unwanted species
  - o Recording common names used for locations and tracks
